

As part of Louisville Water's project to renovate a nearly 100 year old water main, Lexington Road will be closed to through traffic between Grinstead Drive and Stilz Avenue from Monday February 17 to Friday February 28. As with any project of this magnitude unexpected delays can occur. The work will also require the closure of Lexington Road at Top Hill Road and Cochran Hill Road. The Cochran Hill closure only impacts the southside leading into the park. The closure of Lexington Road is necessary so that crews can safely tie into a parallel 24 inch water main. The construction pit for this tie in will require the closure of all four lanes of Lexington Road near Top Hill Road. In order to minimize the length of the road closure crews will be working extended hours Monday to Friday.

The detour will be Grinstead Drive to Stilz Avenue. Postcards are being mailed to impacted residents and Louisville Water is holding a Press Conference on Thursday February 13 at 1:30 to provide detail on the project and road closure.
